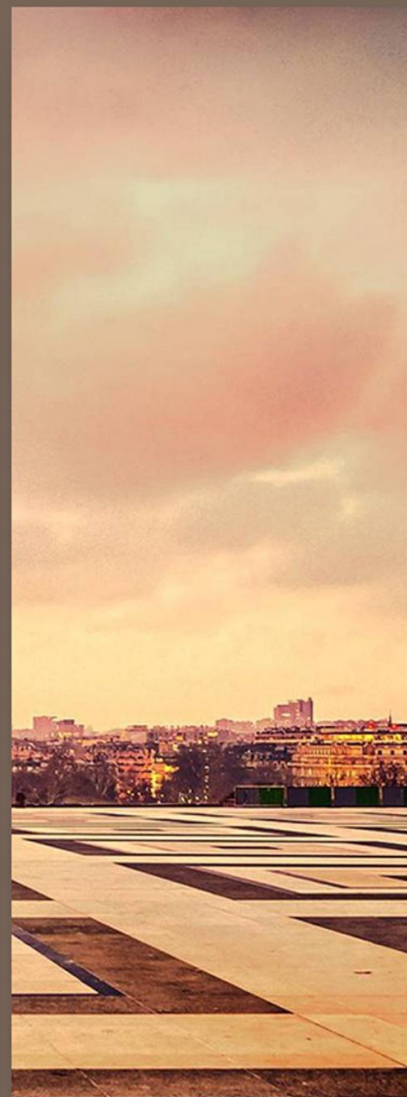
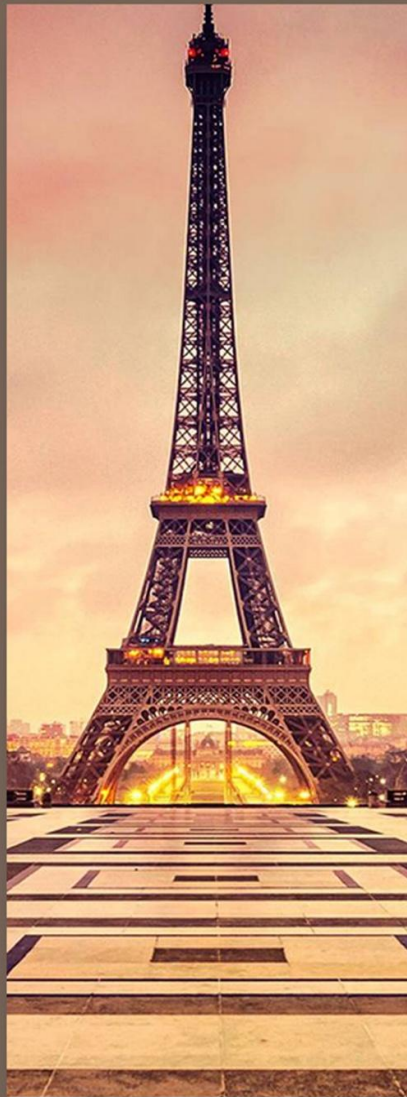

Experiences from Paris

Experience: Complete Paris

(Tour departing from Paris in a private vehicle with guide)

Discover Paris in one unforgettable day, exploring its most iconic monuments, historic neighborhoods and fascinating cultural sites. With stops for photos and contemplation, this tour provides a complete overview of the City of Lights.

Eiffel Tower – The ultimate symbol of Paris, this impressive iron structure has enchanted visitors for over a century.

Panthéon – One of the most iconic buildings in the Latin Quarter, this monument houses the tombs of historical figures such as Voltaire and Victor Hugo.

Opéra Garnier – A jewel of 19th-century architecture, this magnificent opera house enchants with its richness of detail, imposing chandeliers and stunning frescoes.

Place de la Concorde – The largest square in Paris, where the iconic fountain and Egyptian obelisk mark one of the city's most historic settings.

Arc de Triomphe – Built in honor of Napoleon Bonaparte's victories, this historic monument stands out in the heart of the Champs-Élysées. From the top, you can enjoy a spectacular panoramic view of the city.

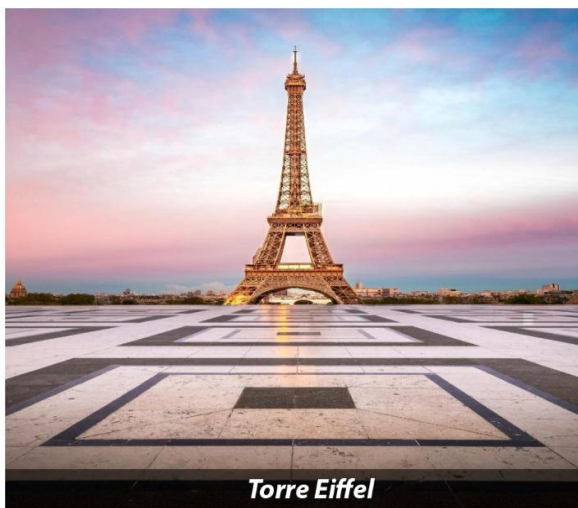
Sacré-Cœur – Located at the highest point in Paris, the Basilica of the Sacred Heart enchants with its imposing architecture and offers one of the most stunning views of the French capital.

Louvre Pyramid – A perfect fusion of ancient and modern, the glass pyramid of the Louvre Museum marks the entrance to one of the most important museums in the world, home to works such as the Mona Lisa and the Venus de Milo.

Notre-Dame – Even after the 2019 fire, the Gothic cathedral remains one of the most symbolic monuments in Paris. Its gargoyles, stained glass windows and architectural details tell centuries of history.

Experience: Mont Saint-Michel Day Trip **(Private guided tour by car)**

Embark on an unforgettable journey to one of France's most iconic destinations:

Mont Saint-Michel. Located in the Normandy region, this spectacular medieval monastery, built on a rocky island, is one of the most visited and photographed sites in the country.

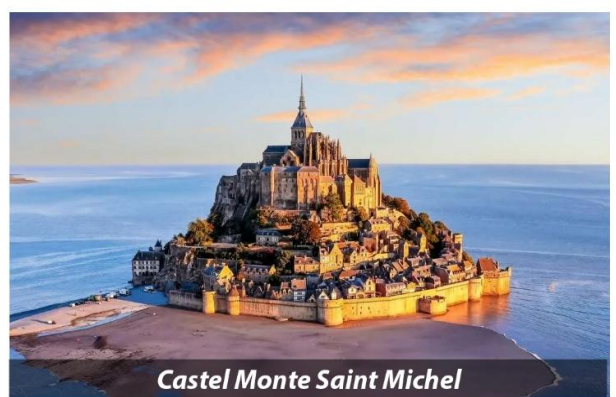

Incredible Photo Spots – The view of Mont Saint-Michel in the distance, especially at sunrise or sunset, is one of the most magical moments of the visit, guaranteeing unforgettable photos.

Experience: Loire Valley – Castle Region

(Private guided tour by car)

Experience: Day Trip to Amsterdam

Anne Frank House – One of the city’s most moving places, where Anne Frank and her family hid during World War II.

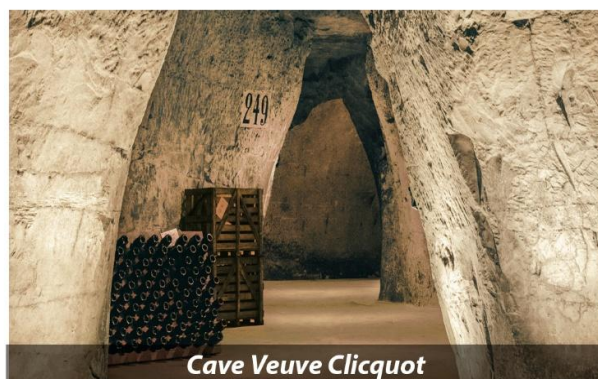

Experience: Day Trip to Brussels

Belgian Beer Tasting – Try the traditional Belgian beers, famous worldwide for their quality and variety of flavors.

Belgian Chocolates and Waffles – Brussels is a gastronomic paradise! Be sure to try the delicious waffles and the renowned artisanal chocolates.

Experience: Day Trip to Bruges

Experience: Strasbourg Day Trip

(Private guided tour by car)

Vauban Dam and Covered Bridges – A set of 17th-century fortifications that offer one of the best vantage points for taking panoramic photos of Strasbourg.

European Parliament – Visit the modern building that houses one of the European Parliament's headquarters and discover Strasbourg's political importance in the European Union.

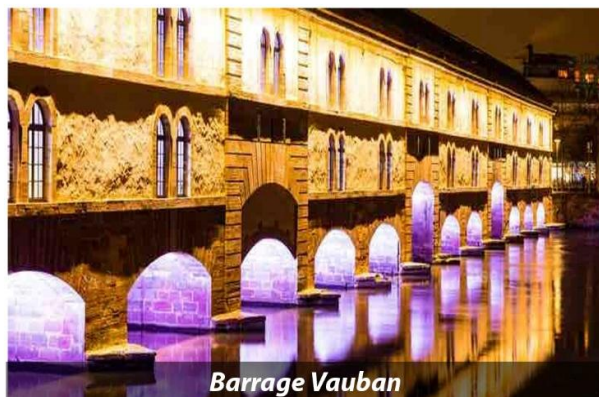
