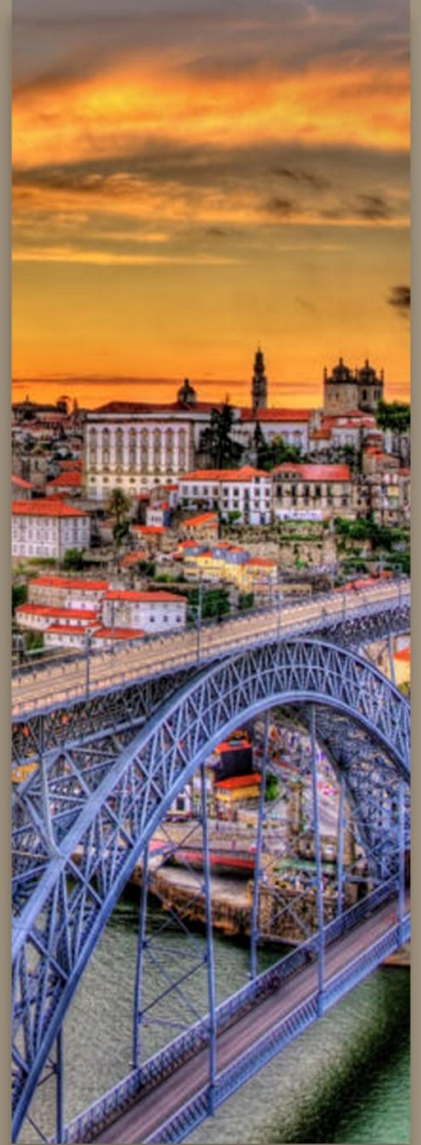

Experiences from Porto

Experience: Experience São João do Porto

(Walking tour, without car support)

Enjoy this unique experience! São João do Porto is one of the most vibrant and authentic popular festivals in Portugal, celebrated on the night of June 23rd to 24th. The city comes alive with music, dancing, fireworks and, of course, delicious traditional food. Come and discover the traditions of this festival and immerse yourself in the festive atmosphere that takes over the streets of Porto!

On a pleasant walk through the city's historic streets, we will learn about the origins of this celebration and understand what makes it so special. Accompanied by an experienced guide, we will pass through the most traditional neighborhoods, where the festival takes place with greater intensity. During the tour, you will be able to taste some of the most famous delicacies of the festival:

Sandúche de leitão – A classic of Portuguese cuisine, made with roasted suckling pig meat and seasoned with spices.

Bifana – Finely seasoned pork sandwich served on crispy bread.

Grilled sardines – The most emblematic dish of the popular festivals, traditionally served on bread or accompanied by potatoes and salad.

You will also see some of the most curious traditions of the festival, such as the use of plastic hammers to gently "hit" other revelers on the head and the custom of releasing hot air balloons, which light up the sky of Porto in an unforgettable spectacle.

Experiences from Porto

Experience: Serra da Estrela (Tour departing from Porto in a private vehicle)

A must-see experience for those who wish to discover one of the most impressive landscapes in Portugal! We will leave **Porto** towards the magnificent **Serra da Estrela**, the highest point in mainland Portugal, at around 2,000 meters above sea level. On the way, we will visit the beautiful Linhares da Beira, one of the 12 Historic **Villages of Portugal**, famous for its preserved medieval architecture and impressive castle dating back to the 13th century.

Upon arrival at **Serra da Estrela**, we will have the opportunity to explore its fascinating ecosystem, enjoy stunning landscapes and learn more about the local **culture** and **traditions**. For food lovers, this tour also has some delicious moments in store, such as tasting the famous **Queijo da Serra**, one of the most iconic products of the region.

During the winter, the mountain range becomes Portugal's main ski destination, and we will visit Torre, its highest point, where the country's only ski resort is located. Even outside the snow season, the region offers spectacular panoramic views and trails perfect for hiking and contemplation.

Experience: Peneda-Gerês National Park

(Tour departing from Porto in a private vehicle).

Explore the largest natural park in Portugal on an unforgettable tour of the **Peneda-Gerês National Park!** We will start the tour from your hotel in Porto and head north, where unspoiled nature and stunning landscapes await you.

Our first stop will be at **Cascata da Portela do Homem**, one of the most beautiful waterfalls in the region, located close to the border with Spain. After a short walk, you will be able to admire the crystal clear water and, on warmer days, even take a refreshing dip!

Next, we will visit the **picturesque village of Soajo**, famous for its old stone granaries, which are part of the region's historical heritage. Here, we will enjoy a delicious typical lunch, where you can taste regional specialties such as roast kid and posta barrosã.

After lunch, we will head to another natural spectacle: the **Poço Negro do Soajo**, a beautiful natural pool with clear waters, perfect for relaxing and admiring the surrounding nature.

After a day full of discoveries and incredible landscapes, we will return to Porto.

Important note: This tour is not recommended for people with disabilities or reduced mobility.

Experiences from Lisbon

Experience: Seville

(2-day tour, departing from Lisbon, by private vehicle).

Get ready to immerse yourself in the charm and history of one of Spain's most iconic cities: Seville! We'll leave Lisbon early and head to this fascinating Andalusian city, famous for its vibrant culture, impressive architecture and delicious cuisine.

Upon arrival, we'll begin our journey with a stroll through the narrow streets of Seville's historic center, where we'll visit some of the city's top tourist attractions:

Metropol Parasol: The world's largest wooden sculpture, also known as "Las Setas" (the mushrooms), an iconic modern structure that offers stunning panoramic views of the city.

Plaza de España: One of Seville's most impressive monuments, built for the 1929 Ibero-American Exposition, with its grandeur and beautiful tiles representing various regions of Spain.

Seville Cathedral: The largest Gothic cathedral in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its imposing interior and the famous Giralda, the tower that was originally a Muslim minaret.

During the walk, we will take several breaks to sample traditional Spanish tapas and savor local culinary delights, such as jamón ibérico, Spanish tortilla and gazpacho.

The next day, we will continue our exploration of the city, visiting:

Torre del Oro: Built on the banks of the Guadalquivir River to protect the city, this medieval tower now houses a naval museum.

Guadalquivir Riverbank: Walk along the river and admire the picturesque views of the city.

Real Maestranza: Seville's famous bullring, considered one of the oldest and most important in Spain, the birthplace of traditional Spanish bullfighting.

After this complete immersion in Seville, we will return to Lisbon in the early afternoon.

Experience: Elvas and Badajoz – Crossing the Border into Spain
(1-day tour, departing from Lisbon, in a private vehicle).

Get ready for a fascinating journey across the borders of Portugal and Spain, where history and culture meet in two incredible destinations!

We will leave Lisbon early and head to the city of Elvas, in Portugal, famous for its imposing fortifications, recognized as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Elvas was a strategic defense point for the country and, as we travel through it, we will explore its characteristic hills, the military forts that surround the city and, of course, the medieval castle, which dominates the landscape.

After this historical immersion, we will cross the border and arrive in **Badajoz, in Spain**, a city full of charm and contrasts. In Badajoz, you will be enchanted by its bridges and gardens, the imposing Badajoz Castle and the old quarter, full of history and tradition. The city is also a true paradise for food lovers, with excellent **tapas restaurants** where you can taste the best of Spanish cuisine.

Experience: Serra da Lousã

(2-day tour, departing from Lisbon, in a private vehicle).

If you are passionate about nature and beautiful landscapes, **Serra da Lousã** is the perfect destination! We will explore one of the routes of the **Schist Villages**, a group of traditional and authentic villages, built with the characteristic schist, a local stone that gives the villages a grayish tone and a unique beauty.

We will start our tour by visiting **Talasnal and Casal Novo**, two of the most charming villages in the region. As you walk through the quiet streets, you will see how the schist houses integrate perfectly with the natural environment, creating a charming and welcoming setting.

After this first day of exploration, we suggest spending the night in the **small village of Lousã**, where the tranquility and local hospitality are the highlight. On the second day, we will go to Castelo da Lousã, a medieval building with a privileged view of the region. After visiting the castle, it's time to enjoy some typical regional food with a delicious lunch at the nearby **O Burgo restaurant**.

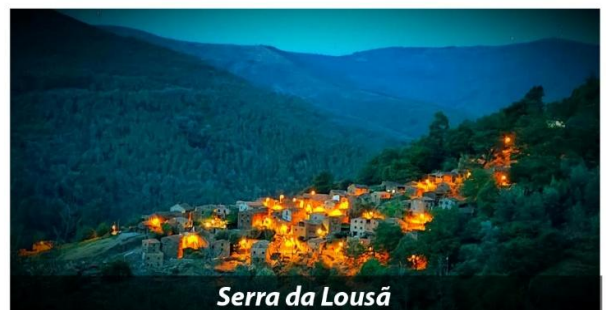

Experience: Piódão, the Nativity Scene Village

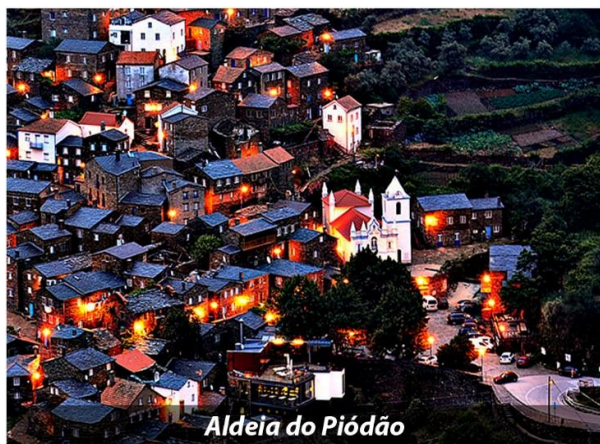

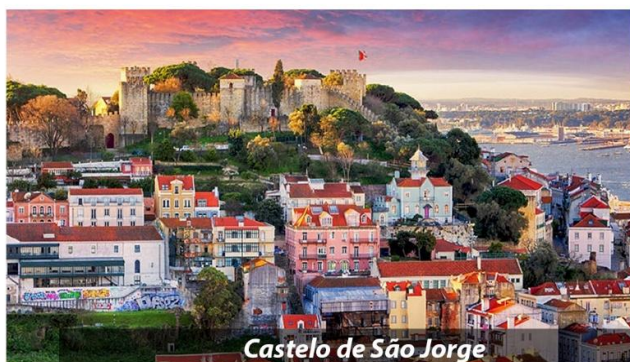
