Sightseeing + Cycling Tour

Day 1: Porto

Experience Summary:

Arrival, welcome, and free time to explore the city.

Porto's Ribeira (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), São Bento Train Station, Bolhão Market, the Port Wine Cellars in Vila Nova de Gaia, and the iconic Luís I Bridge with stunning views of the Douro River.

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Day 2: Porto to Vila do Conde (35 km)

Experience Summary:

A scenic coastal ride with Atlantic breezes and breathtaking views.

Matosinhos Beach, the Monastery of Leça do Balio (a significant historical site on the Camino de Santiago), and the charming town of Vila do Conde, home to a remarkable historic aqueduct.

Fun Fact:

Vila do Conde is one of the oldest cities in Portugal, known for its rich nautical and historical heritage. The Santa Clara Aqueduct, with its 999 arches, is an impressive landmark.

Experience:

3º dia: Vila do Conde a Viana do Castelo (49 km)

Trajetos com paisagens variadas, passando por praias, rios e vilarejos pitorescos.

Destaques:

A cidade histórica de Esposende, as paisagens do Parque Natural do Litoral Norte e o Santuário de Santa Luzia, em Viana do Castelo, com vista panorâmica da região.

Curiosidades:

Viana do Castelo é famosa pelo seu artesanato, especialmente o traje típico da região, e pelas festividades religiosas. O Santuário de Santa Luzia oferece uma das vistas mais belas de Portugal.

Experiência (opcional, não inclusa):

Visita guiada ao centro histórico de Viana, com suas ruas medievais e museus locais.



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Day 4: Viana do Castelo to Oia (46 km)

After crossing the border into Spain, explore the Monastery of Oia.

Fun Fact:

Founded in the 12th century, the Monastery of Oia is one of the most iconic landmarks on the Galician coast, blending spirituality with natural beauty.



Day 5: Oia to Vigo (43 km)

Cycle along the coast to the vibrant city of Vigo.

Highlights:

The coastal landscapes of Galicia, the Bay of Vigo, and the city's lively cultural scene.

Fun Fact:

Vigo is the largest city in Galicia and home to one of the region's most important fishing ports. It is renowned for its seafood cuisine and the nearby Cíes Islands—a natural paradise.



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Day 6: Vigo to Pontevedra (34 km)

Coastal bike paths and traditional villages lead to the medieval town of Pontevedra.

Highlights:

The historic center of Pontevedra, with its picturesque squares, ancient churches, and the Basilica of Santa María.

Fun Fact:

Pontevedra is known as a pedestrian-friendly city, with a well-preserved and lively historic center—perfect for exploring on foot.



Day 7: Pontevedra to Padrón (41 km)

A peaceful rural route to Padrón, known for its connection to the Apostle Saint James.

Highlights:

Historic churches, the Sar River, and the Sanctuary of Our Lady of La Escravitude.

Fun Fact:

According to tradition, Padrón is the place where the remains of the Apostle Saint James arrived by boat from Palestine, making it one of the most significant landmarks on the Camino de Santiago.



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Day 8: Padrón to Santiago (25 km)

Complete your journey as you catch sight of the towers of Santiago Cathedral.

Highlights:

An emotional arrival at Obradoiro Square and a visit to the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela.

Fun Fact:

The Cathedral of Santiago is one of the most important pilgrimage destinations in the Christian world and houses the tomb of the Apostle James. Every year, thousands of pilgrims arrive seeking spiritual renewal.



Day 9: Departure from Santiago

After breakfast, farewell and return.
